- Does the insured have an effective hazards communication program and do all workers have access to MSDSs?
- How many workers does the insured employ?
- What are the insured's hours of operation?
- Are all machinists qualified to use the machines they work on?
- Are pre-placement physicals given before job assignments are made?
- What types of parts does the insured machine?
- Do workers use more than one machine?
- What is the layout and overall condition of the shop area?
- What type of machines does the insured use and how many are there of each type?
What is their condition?
- What is the maintenance schedule for machines? Is this subcontracted out? If so, are insured subcontractors used. Are machines equipped with a lock out to prevent injuries to employees perform maintenance on the equipment?
- Does the insured have Vacuum dust collectors on their premises?
Can be fitted to the machines at the point of operation?
- What is the housekeeping in the work area?
- What type of coolant does the insured use? Does any of the coolant ever escape and spray at workers?
- What kind of cleaning solutions or solvents does the insured use?
- What kind of personal protective equipment do employees wear when working with chemicals and machinery?
- Does the insured always provide the proper materials-handling devices?
- Does the insured use or hire the use of a crane or other hoisting equipment?
- Does the insured do any welding on the premises?
- What kind of inspection and maintenance schedules has the insured set up for machinery?
- Are any employees instructed in first aid?
- Does the insured have eyewash stations provided for workers handling chemicals?
